- Shadow seasoned sorors; join committee with Mentors; assignment as committee co-chair position
- Attend chapter-sponsored chapter sponsored “**Leadership Academy**” for training in Parliamentary Procedures, function of Committees, etc.
- Undergraduate Advisory Team-Models standards for Undergraduates.(Active leadership in NPHC of graduate level,
