Z-HOPETM MILITARY INITIATIVE ELDER CARE CENTER VETERANS DAY PARTY

GOAL: To show appreciation to Veterans across America

COMPONENT: Spirit

TIMELINE: November (Target month, but events can be conducted any time of the year.)

AUDIENCE: Women, Men and Seniors

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Chapters should contact their local Elder Care Centers to make arrangements to sponsor a celebration.
- 2. Chapters should plan activities that agree with the level comparable with the mental capability of the patients.
- 3. Chapters should research all US component service songs in preparation to play each song honoring the branch the veteran served.
- 4. Chapters should publicize the drive and encourage the donation from local venders to offset cost of the celebration.
- 5. Chapters should research prepare a small momento based on the branch of service to leave with the veteran.

OVERVIEW

Local Chapters may take advantage of several opportunities to perform volunteer work at Veteran Hospitals, Veterans of Foreign Wars Centers, Children's Homes/Hospitals, or similar locations where current and former military members/family members may be found. Also we have added several suggestions for various collection drives. Chapters are invited to choose from any of the suggested Military activities below:

- a. Host the "Women in the Military" Z-HOPE™ Program, or an appropriate existing program within the updated Z-HOPE™ Manual, to be done at a Veteran's Hospital, Veterans of Foreign Wars Centers, or with a military veteran-owned business.
- b. Establish contact with a local Veterans Hospital/Children's Hospitals/Foster Homes and sign up for existing volunteer activities.
- c. Make a monetary donation to any credible military-based / veteran-owned /disabled veteran organization. (Examples: https://www.finalsaluteinc.org, www.womenveteransinteractive.org, or any other credible organization which support veterans)

Z-HOPE™ POINTS - In accordance with the Z-HOPE™ Official Toolkit:

Z-HOPE™ MILITARY INITIATIVE VETERANS TOILETRY DRIVE / DONATIONS

GOAL: To Provide Toiletries for The Basic Needs Of Homeless, Hospitalized, and Disenfranchised Veterans

COMPONENT: Spirit

TIMELINE: Year Round

AUDIENCE: Women, Men and Seniors

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Chapters should contact their local Veterans Administration Centers to establish a point of contact and donation information.
- 2. Chapters should plan to establish one or more collections areas within their communities. (IE: churches, schools, senior citizen centers, etc).
- 3. Chapters should publicize the drive and encourage the donation of items such as: shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, hair brushes, deodorant, bar soap, disposable razors, shaving cream, hand and body lotion, mouth wash, etc.
- 4. Chapter Z-HOPE™ Committee members should establish delivery throughout the year of the toiletries.

Z-HOPE™ POINTS - In accordance with the Z-HOPE™ Official Tookit:

- Minimum number of toiletries required in order to receive Z-HOPE™ points = 50
 - 50 toiletries = 50 points
 - Packaged items count as 1 Item i.e. a 18 Pack of Sanitary Napkins = 1 Pack = 1 Point
 - If you collect more than the minimum, your Z-HOPE™ points will increase by one point per toiletry
- Only activities with at least 20 persons (non-members) and 4 Zetas/Amicae in attendance will be counted in the competition for all activities in the Z-HOPE™ Manual and Toolkits unless otherwise specified by National Headquarters, Region, or State.

PROCEDURE: Sponsor wreaths at a cemetery near you

- 1. Research sponsoring a veterans' wreath at a cemetery near you, volunteer, or donate to a local sponsorship group.
- 2. Chapters should contact The Wreaths Across America Organization to establish their respective volunteer role. (IE: help lay wreaths, coordinate a ceremony, truck driver, clean up-crew, delivery, etc).
