Autism Awareness is a newly developed capstone initiative that is established under the Members' Administration. The purpose of this initiative is to provide education, information, and resources about Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) so that the membership may be more knowledgeable about the subject matter, and thus, engage, inform, and impact local communities of color.

Autism is a complex developmental disability which affects a person's ability to communicate and interact with others.

Signs of autism usually begin to show during the early childhood years. Autism affects a person's ability to communicate and interact with others. As a result, persons on the autism spectrum display behaviors that may include challenges with executive functioning, delayed development of language, lack of eye contact, poor motor skills, and sensory sensitivities (Autism Society, 2016b). As well, they may have a difficult time understanding 'typical' social cues and social behaviors and may face challenges engaging with those around them. Autism looks different for every person and affects everyone differently—that's why it's called a "spectrum".

Children of color tend to be less often and later diagnosed (Autism Speaks, 2021). Being diagnosed at a later age suggests socioeconomic concerns and knowledge deficits about the disorder and typical developmental milestones as barriers. Unfortunately, these barriers lead to delayed access to evaluations, diagnosis, and services.

In 2020, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention issued their ADDM autism prevalence report. The report concluded that the prevalence of autism had risen to 1 in every 54 births in the United States – this breaks down to 1 in 34 boys and 1 in 144 girls (Autism Speaks, 2021). Autism is one of the fastest growing neurological conditions in the world.

Embrace the initiative in your community to make a difference in the lives of those on the autism spectrum and their families.
